

# Mill Creek Homeowners' Association Swimming Pool Rules & Information

## Hours of Operation

- ∞ Season will be from Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day.
- ∞ The swimming pool will be open **on Monday through Friday** from: **Noon - 8:00 PM** and on **Saturday and Sunday** from: **11:00AM - 7:00PM**.
- ∞ When school is in session, the pool will be open school days: **4:00PM – 8:00PM**.
- ∞ Exceptions include inclement weather and temperatures below 68 degrees.

## Rest Break

- ∞ Rest breaks are scheduled the last 15 minutes of each hour, except the last hour at the end of the day. All swimmers under 18 are required to exit the pool during rest break. All swimmers under 18 must completely exit the pool and zero-entry at rest break.

## Proper Identification

- ∞ Current, 2008 id\_tags must be shown to the Lifeguard to be admitted to the pool area and sign in at the guest book is required. One tag will be distributed to each household with paid Association fees.
- ∞ Children under the age of 14 MUST be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- ∞ Children ages 14 – 17 may NOT be responsible for children under the age of 14.
- ∞ Parents are responsible for and are expected to supervise their children at all times in the pool area.

## Guests

- ∞ Guests must be accompanied by an adult resident at all times in the pool area.
- ∞ Residents must register with the Lifeguard, sign the guest book and are responsible for guests' conduct.
- ∞ The guest policy will be monitored, especially on weekends and holidays to determine whether limits need to be imposed. Capacity of the pool is 54.

## Safety & Conduct

- ∞ No running, diving or boisterous behavior. Lifeguards have the authority to control activities to maintain safe conditions.
- ∞ Repeat offenders will face the following consequences:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> offense – warning
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> offense – 10 minutes out of the pool
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> offense – out of pool area for the remainder of the day
  - 4<sup>th</sup> offense – no pool privileges for one week
  - 5<sup>th</sup> offense – revocation of pool area privileges for remainder of 2008 season
- ∞ No air mattresses or floatation devices are allowed due to obstructed views for Lifeguard
- ∞ Certain types of toys and balls may be allowed at the discretion of the Lifeguard
- ∞ No pets of any size or type allowed in the pool area
- ∞ No smoking in the pool area
- ∞ All music devices (radio, iPod, etc..) must have personal headphones or other hearing device
- ∞ The pool's telephone is for emergencies and restricted to Lifeguards ONLY.

## Community Center

The downstairs restroom will remain open during pool hours and are for use of pool patrons and Lifeguards only. Rental of the Community Center does NOT include use of the pool and the pool area.

## Food & Beverages

- ∞ Snack-type food is permitted in the pool area.
- ∞ Residents and guests must clean-up after themselves. Trash bins are provided
- ∞ **NO** Alcoholic beverages of any kind permitted.
- ∞ **NO** glass containers of any kind permitted.

April 2008

Issue guest passes. The sizes of the passes are the size of a business card and have 10 to 20 "guest admittances".

They would be shown to the Lifeguard every time you bring a guest to the pool. The Lifeguard will be asked to punch out the numbers.

If a homeowner goes through a pass, then they are required to have a new one issued with a fee. (suggested fee \$20.00 for 20 passes) We can have them printed on a specific color paper for the guards to look for.

If we allow these then we have to change the number of guest allowed at one time (we have 2 at this time per household). We could make it 4 or 5 maximum.

We need to clarify this very well – be aware that someone may try to bring 20 guests all at one time or bring them from the community center rental.

See sample (I will have this at the meeting). We would need to have the pool tag number/homeowners name printed on these in advance to discourage some homeowners from giving them to others.
